The meeting is expected to provide a clear guidance, vital considerations and also a mandate for the Consultative group 2, which is mainly tasked with initiatives aimed at improving and acting as progress catalyst for DRM reforms in line with commitment 2.

The ATI Stockholm Meetings will be held back-to-back to the [Stockholm Tax Conference](#). Sweden will host the Conference on Capacity Building concerning Taxation at the Waterfront Congress Centre in Stockholm on 30-31 May 2018. With the aim of contributing to strengthen tax administrations across the globe, the Conference will provide an opportunity for experience exchange and feature case studies for mutual learning on successful capacity building in taxation. Sweden has invited all ATI members to its Conference. Funding for partner countries' travel and accommodation costs is provided by the Swedish government.

For ATI partner country representatives, the ITC might take over accommodation costs for the night of 31 May, with funding provided by the German Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) and the European Union. Partner country participants can apply for funding of accommodation (one night) during the registration process. The distribution of funding is dependent on funds available and cannot be guaranteed at the stage of the registration.
