1. Background

As a multi-stakeholder partnership, the ATI lives of the vast experiences and variety of perspectives that ATI members bring to the table. The ATI Consultative Groups were first constituted in 2018 to facilitate consultation and the exchange of experiences, promote peer learning and execute activities to support the fulfilment of the ATI commitments.

In line with the launch of the [ATI Declaration 2025](#) in November 2020, four new ATI Consultative Groups have been initiated in the course of the 2020 ATI General Assembly.
