The ATI Consultative Group 3 is delighted to invite you to join the first session of the webinar series on taxation of official development assistance (ODA).

Granting of tax exemptions for projects financed by ODA is a long-standing practice that has been contested within the space of development financing. Given its importance, the topic has increasingly gained attention within the ATI as it is particularly relevant to the implementation of Commitment 3 of the new [ATI Declaration 2025](#), through which ATI members commit to apply coherent and coordinated policies that foster domestic revenue mobilisation (DRM).

The objective of this webinar on ODA taxation is twofold. First, it aims to present to ATI members the guidelines recently published by the United Nations Committee of Experts on International Cooperation to support countries considering and negotiating agreements on the tax treatment of government-to-government aid. Secondly, the session seeks to facilitate the sharing of experience between ATI development partners, partner countries and supporting organisations in order to advance reforms for greater transparency and coherence in the DRM agenda. ATI Consultative Group 3 will follow-up on the outcomes of the webinar.
